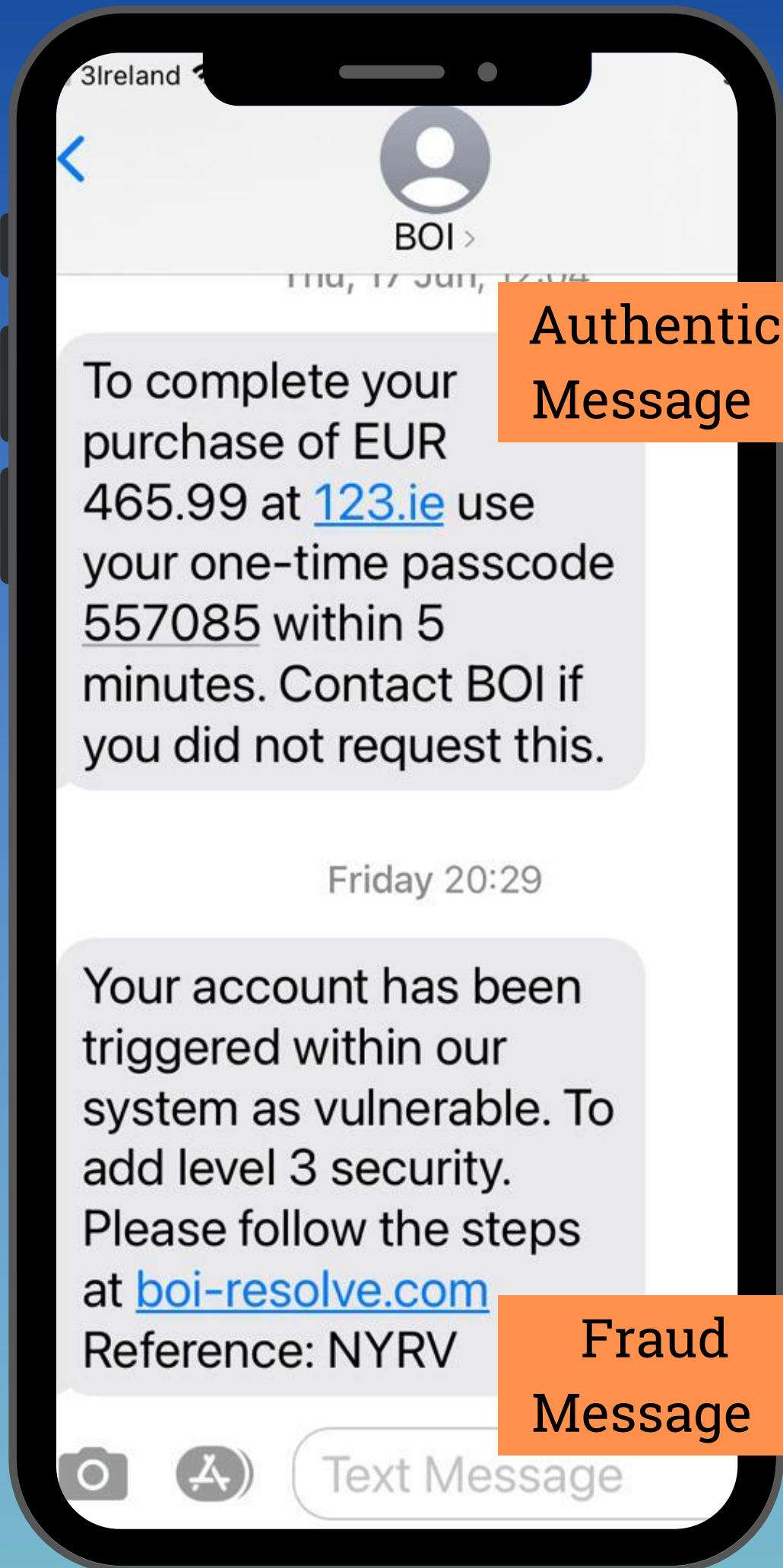

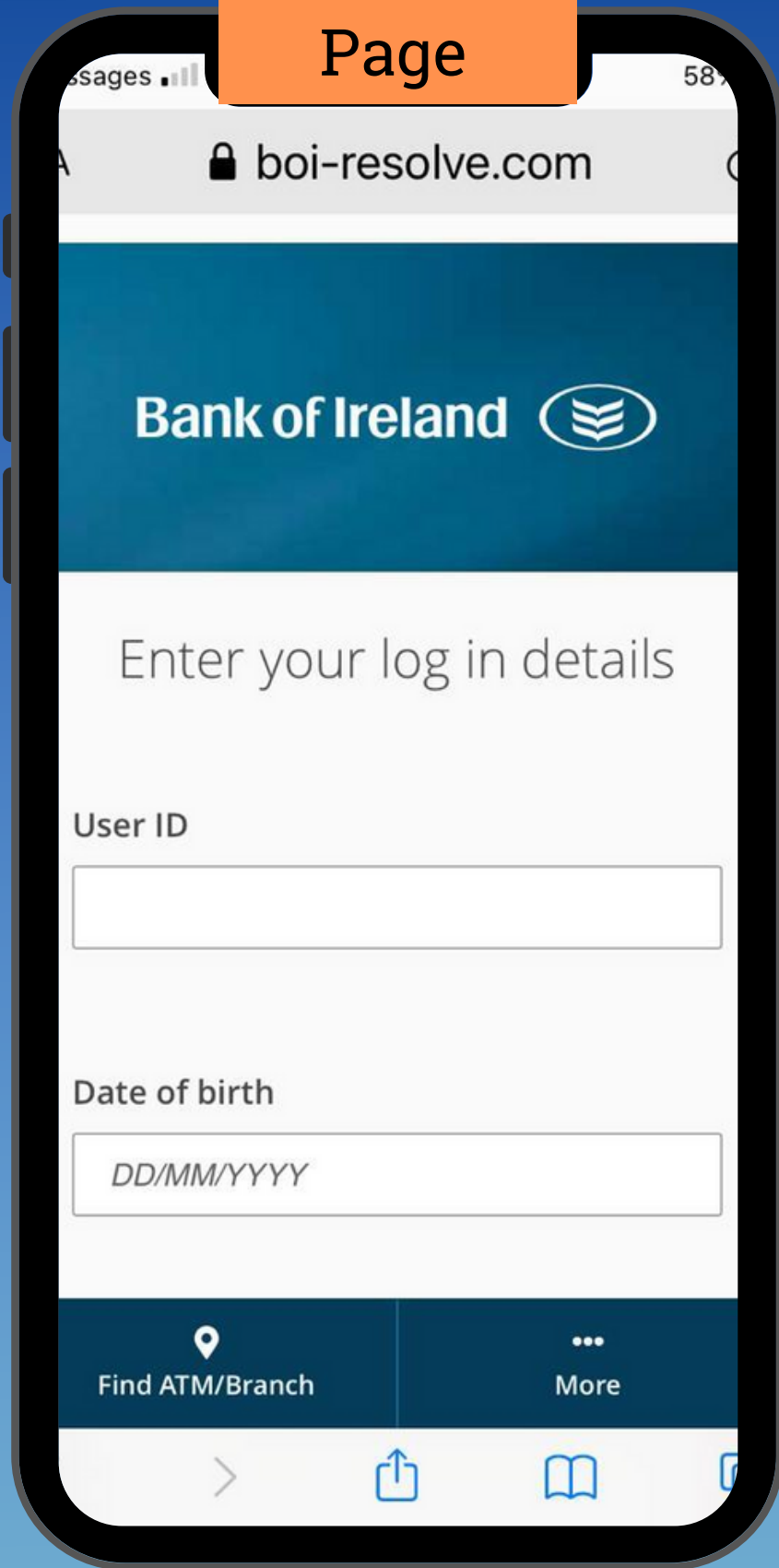

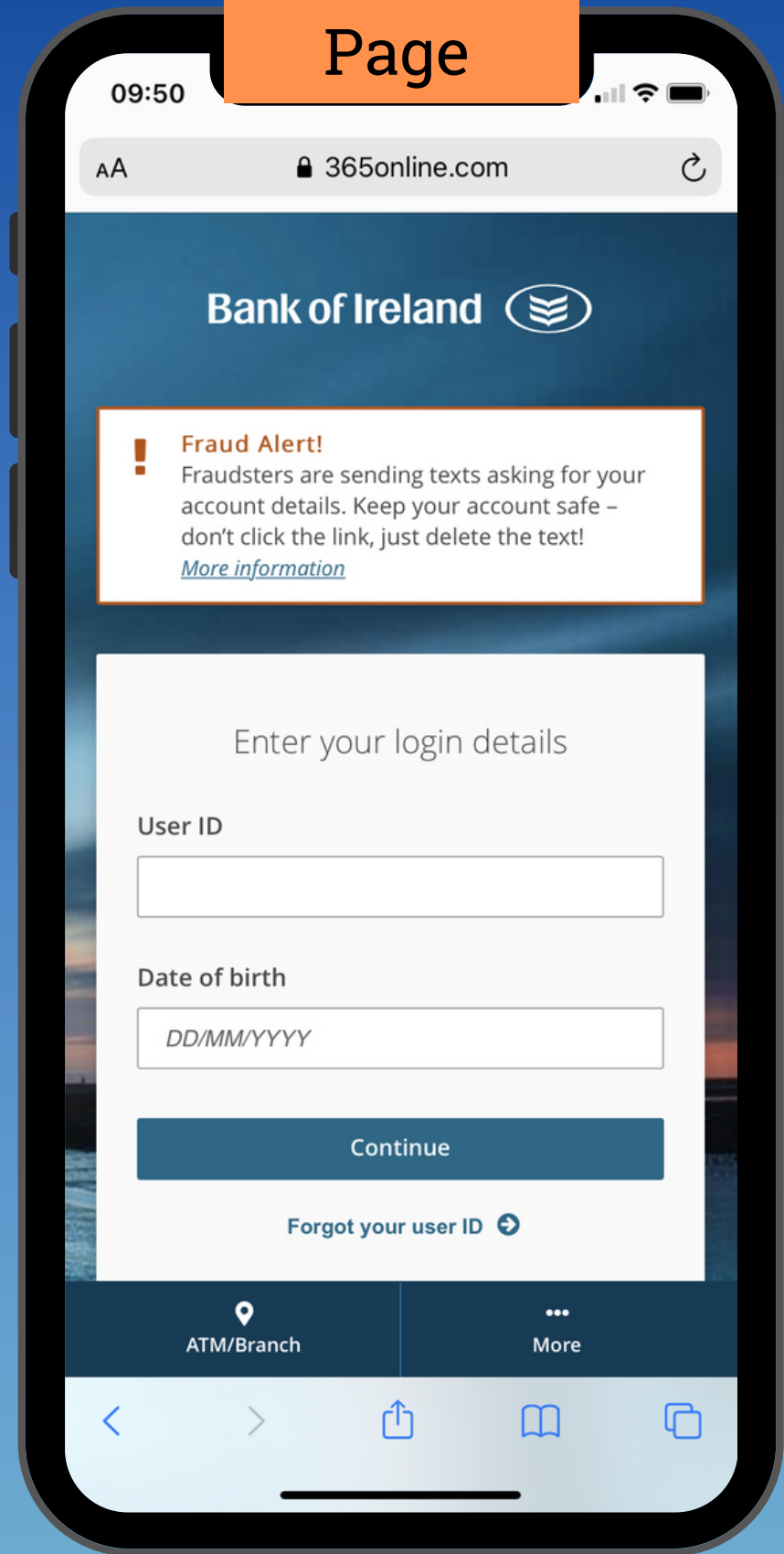
Scam message with sender ID as Bank of Ireland (BOI), so it looks authentic

The link brings you to a BOI replica page. There is hardly any noticeable difference at first glance. Easier for people to fall prey to such scams



Spotting the Scams: Corrata VS other Security Providers



Corrata blocked the phishing link instantly as a zero-day threat



Only 5 out of 88 security vendors on VirusTotal marked it malicious 3 days after the text was received



Chrome blocked the site 2 days after the message was received
